ANNUAL REPORT-2022-2023 PRABODHINI GURUKULA

The annual activities of Prabodhinee Gurukula begin with Vedic Shiksha Varga. Following is a brief report of the activities held throughout the year.

Veda Shiksha Varga

The Veda Shiksha class, which has been continuously conducted for the last 43 years under the auspices of Prabodhinee Trust, started this time on Wednesday 30-03-2022 through Panchgavya Homa and Deeksha and ended on 09-04-2022. A total of 49 students from 27 seats in 18 districts of Karnataka participated in this class.

New School Entrance Festival -2022

On Sunday 19-06-2022, a new Chhatra entry ceremony was held at Prabodhinee Gurukula, Hariharpur. 22 students were admitted to the Gurukula through the Brahmakurcha Havan held in the morning. Swami Jitakamananda Ji, President of Ramakrishna Ashram, Mangalore gave the first lesson to the new children. Swami Jitakamananda ji gave blessings in the meeting program held later. The keynote speech was delivered by Mr. Kazampadi Subrahmanya Bhat, an invited member of the All India Executive Council of RSS. Mr. HC Asrash, a young entrepreneur and the

July 13 Guru Puja Utsav

Shri Guru Puja Festival of R.S.S. was celebrated on 13th July and a session was conducted by Shri Rajendra Kumar, Gurudakshina was dedicated to many teachers and scholars who came to the Gurukula from outside to teach.

- On 21st July e Sri Sri Jagadguru Dr. of Kashi Veerashaiva Mahapeeth Mallikarjuna Vishwaradhya Shivacharya Maha Swamiji arrived at the Gurukula and gave his blessings.
- On July 27, Mr. T. N. Prabhakar, senior member of the Gurukul Margadarshaka Board, arrived at Gurukul. launched of the monthly handwritten magazine "Saurabha" created by the students, then interacted with the Acharya.
- Shravan Masa was celebrated as Sanskrit Masa for a whole month from 29th July
- August 11 Raksha bandhan program was celebrated in 5 surrounding schools and more than 350 households were contacted every month who give Mushti Dhanya. Raksha Bandhan Utsav was celebrated in Gurukula on 12th August. During Raksha Bandhan, 1955 houses of 18 villages were contacted.

- August 15. Swarajya Amrita Mahotsava Students performed the drama of Sangolli Rayanna on the occasion of Amrita Mahotsava of Independence Day. For this drama performance, Shri Uma Maheshwar from Ninasam stayed in the Gurukula for 15 days and trained the students .On that day, a Vanamahotsava program was held on behalf of the Koppa Lions Club in the Gurukula premises.
- On August 22 Prabodhinee Gurukula, State President of Akhil Bharat Sahitya Parishad, Dr. | Na Mogasale visited and consulted with the students and faculty members.
- Parent Training 4-9-2022 Parent Training Programme of Prabodhinee Gurukula was held. The training consisted of group sessions and mass sessions. Special sessions were held as part of the Amrut Mahotsava of Independence with topics like good routine, true nature of patriotism, self-reliant village, Indian history, our home, food and health, etc.
- Kannada Sangh Kantavara Award: The prestigious organization of the country Kannada Sangh Kantavara presented the "Cultural Integration" award to the Prabodhinee Trust on November 1, which is given every year during the Karnataka Rajyotsava. On this occasion, Trustee Mr. Rajagopal and members of the Trust were present and received the honour.
- On Sunday 20-11-2022, a "Gurukula Introductory Program" was conducted as part of the "Yogkshema Yoga Kendra (R)" awareness (one lecture per month) program under the leadership of Mr. Virupaksha Belawadi, a renowned yoga trainer and international Aryabhata awardee practitioner of Bangalore.
- **Bhagavad Gita Abhiyan**: On the occasion of Gita Jayanti November 30th to 7 days Bhagavad Gita Abhiyan was conducted in 4 surrounding schools. 300 children participated and engaged in Bhagavad Gita study
- From December 24th to 31st, our students participated in a week-long Cow-product manufacturing training camp at Kaujalagi and got specialized training.

- Ganga Samaradhana: Ganga Samaradhana started with Ganga welcome at Prabodhinee Gurukulam on 11:02:2023 evening. That evening Shri Govinda, siniour Pracharak of RSS Dakshina Madhyamkshetra, delivered the keynote speech at the Bharatmata Pujana. On 12:02:2023 morning the program started with Sankalpa Snanam at Tunga Tir. Later, Sankalpa of Sri Ramtaraka Homa was held and the main speech of the program was delivered by the Akhil Bharath Sampark Pramukh of the RSS Shri Ramlal Ji. Then Mr. Kajampadi Subrahmanya Bhat, an elder of the Gurukula, gave detailed information about the path, development and growth of the Gurukula.
